9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon = \$140 per month

#### **4 year old classes:**

3-day program Monday/Wednesday/Friday ½ day session >  
8:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. or 12:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. = \$180 per month

3-day program Monday/Wednesday/Friday Full day session >  
9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. = \$320 per month

1-day program Tuesday ½ day session >  
12:30 - 3:30 = \$65 per month
